



HOTEL RULES FOR ACCOMMODATION WITH PETS

Dogs and other pets may only share a room with prior notification, and provided that the owner agrees to and respects these hotel rules for stays with pets.

- Dogs and other animals are not allowed in the wellness centre, the restaurant, the swimming pool, or the playground.
- The owner is fully responsible for the animal.
- In all public areas of the hotel, every dog must be kept on a leash.
- Walking dogs is permitted outside the hotel grounds.
- Guests are required to clean up after their dogs in the area around the hotel.
- Guests are required to ensure that the dog does not disturb other hotel guests in any way, for example by barking. If a dog or other animal demonstrably and significantly disturbs other guests, the hotel may terminate the stay without compensation.
- It is forbidden to leave the animal unattended (e.g. in the room) where this could disturb other guests or risk causing property damage or injury to other persons. In the event of any problems, the animal's owner is obliged to compensate for the damage caused and bears full responsibility for the animal's behaviour.
- In the event of any damage to hotel property caused by the animal, the guest is obliged to pay for the damage in full.
- Cleaning and inspection of the room where the guest is staying with the animal must be permitted in a way that does not put staff or other hotel guests at risk. Inspection must be allowed at least once a day, to check for any damage or excessive soiling.

Price list for dog accommodation:

- Small breeds (up to 25 cm) – CZK 400
- Medium breeds (up to 40 cm) – CZK 500
- Larger breeds cannot be accommodated

These rules for accommodation with pets are valid from 1 January 2025
